Physical literacy/FMS- measuring, implementing and tracking students' physical literacy/FMS within school physical education (Missy Parker)

Teacher Voice- investigating their perspectives on recent developments in Irish Physical Education (Mary O'Sullivan)

Essential criteria for applicant:

BSc/BEd in Physical Education or cognate discipline

Currently teaching Physical Education in a Post Primary School
